Steps to make ink monsters

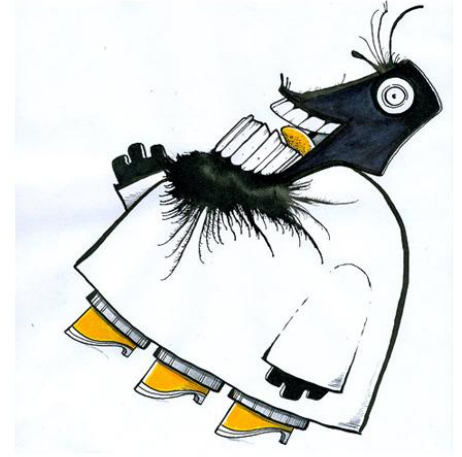
1. Rotate paper to visualize monster
